NEW BUSINESS:-

Item 1

Item 3

Peter Menzies advised that he had had an enquiry from some Buggy competitors regarding competing at the Mandalay Rallysprint. Present graded tracks are unsuitable for this type of vehicle however organizers are looking into different areas on the property with the view of being able to run off – road vehicles sometime in the future.

Item 4

Peter Menzies and Peter Goltz advised that Bunnings in Yeppoon were seeking clubs for sausage sizzles. They asked if the club had considered these at Bunnings or SuperCheap. These events were good income.

As the Junior Development proposal incorporated sausage sizzles at IGA, this matter would need to be sorted before the club could arrange anything else.

Gordon advised that he had done a stocktake on some of the Club's equipment and approx. 30% of vests are missing, 50% of stop watches, 80% of radios.
