The Event is a competitive event, designed to test the skill of the driver and co-driver, and the reliability and mechanical condition of the competing vehicle.

## 2. Authority

The event shall be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including appendices and the National Competition Rules of CAMS Ltd, the National Rally Code (NRC), and the CAMS 2019 Rallysprint standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations which may be issued by the organisers and approved by CAMS Ltd.

## 7. Alteration to, Abandonment or Protest of the Event

In accordance with NCR 59, the Organisers reserve the right to abandon, alter or terminate the event at any point.

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

## 8. Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

## 9. Competition Details

Event Type - S2 Rallysprint as per 2019 CAMS Manual of Motorsport Rally/Road Rallysprint Standing Regulations 1.2 (b)

Entries: Minimum of 10 Entries  
Maximum number of 30 Entries

Licence Requirements as follows:

**Driver:** A minimum of CAMS Clubman Rally (CR) Licence

**Co-Driver:** A minimum of CAMS Clubman Rally Navigator (CRN) Licence

*As Per Section 6 of 2019 CAMS Rallysprint Standing Regulations*

## 10. Vehicle Requirements

Vehicles must comply with Section 8 of the 2019 CAMS Rallysprint Standing Regulations and Schedule A of CAMS manual.

Classes:-

**2WD under** 0-2000cc

**2WD over** 2001cc and above

**All 4WD vehicles** (minimum of 3 or more entries required to make these classes)

**Junior and Ladies** (minimum of 3 or more entries required to make these classes)

## **11. Apparel**

As Per Schedule D of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

NOTE: Frontal Head Restraints and driving suits are STRONGLY RECOMMENDED.

## **12. Event Format**

No. of Stages: Two (2)  
No. of Attempts: 3 Forward & 3 Reverse per stage (subject to time and day light)  
Stage Length(s): Approx. 8km  
TOTAL event length: 96 km maximum

## **14. Starting Order**

The starting order will be determined by the organising committee.

## **15. Change of Entry**

Competitors may, at any time up to the close of Documentation Verification, change the vehicle or crew members upon written notification to the Clerk of Course.

## **16. Crew Eligibility**

Crews must comprise two persons, one designated as the Driver and one as the Co-Driver.

The Driver may have up to 2 different Co-Drivers. The Driver will be required to compete in the same vehicle throughout the event.

All drivers must hold a current civil driving licence.

The minimum age for co-drivers for this event is: 14 years as per 2019 Rallysprint standing Regulations 6.

## **17. Competitors Briefing**

A Competitors Briefing will be held as per TABLE 1 EVENT PROGRAMME Item 1.5 at the event headquarters. It is required that all competitors attend and be present for the entire duration of this briefing

## **18. Scrutineering**

Competitors living within 50Km of Rockhampton are required to attend the location TABLE 1 Item 1.2

At Scrutineering competitors will be required to present:

- All Documents as per Item 19

- Helmets
- The car in a “ready to rally” condition, including driving lights (if they will be used).

Competitors living more than 50 Km from Rockhampton, please contact your regional scrutineer.

Documentation for non-local competitors must be presented as per TABLE 1 Item 1.4

## 19. Documentation

At Documentation Verification competitors will be required to present:

- Completed Scrutineering form
- Current Competition Licences for the Driver / Co-Driver
- Current CAMS affiliated Car Club Membership – Driver / Co-Driver
- Vehicle Registration Papers
- Proof of Third Party Insurance extension for motorsport.
- Authority to Operate (if required)

## 20. Rallysprint Headquarters

Rallysprint Headquarters will be located at the Pit Area at Byfield.

A detailed map will be forwarded to all entrants prior to the event

## 21. Servicing

All servicing will take place at the Service Park.

For reasons of competitor and service crew safety, no Servicing or Refuelling is permitted outside designated Service Areas / Refuelling areas.

There is NO PUMP FUEL available at the Service Park.

Fuel must be purchased prior to the event, nearest fuel is at Byfield Store. (approx. 15 kilometres)

All service crew members details must be completed on the Entry Form.

## 22. Course Markings

The finish of stages will be indicated by a Yellow Chequered Flag board prior to the timing line and a Red Chequered Flag Board on the timing line.

## 23. Starting and Running Order

Competition Numbers will be issued at documentation verification.

Cars will run in numerical order, starting at intervals of no less than two (2) minutes.

It is the competitor’s responsibility to be ready on time and in order at the start of each run.

If a competitor is unable to start a run in their car order, they are to notify the Clerk of Course immediately.

A penalty of 20 minutes will be allocated for this run.

## 25. Penalties

The Clerk of Course reserves the right to take into account all official documents when compiling the results, including control cards and to correct any verified recording errors.

## 26. Results

Each run will be timed and recorded to the second.

All result will be posted on the CQMSC website.

## 27. Finishing Qualifications

Competitors must start each section under the vehicle’s own motive force and must complete the section

without assistance from other vehicles within a late time of 20 minutes.

## **28. Updates**

Any further Supplementary Regulations will be posted on the CQMSC web page and facebook page

## **29. Safety**

All personnel are asked to assess the risks associated with any practice that they are involved with, and take action to minimise the potential injury to themselves and any other personnel.

Please observe the following rules to assist our event to be a safe one.

- No smoking within the service park (smoking area will be in place.)
- Jack stands must be used when working under vehicle
- Suitable fire extinguisher will be supplied in the refuelling area.
- Suitable Fire Extinguisher at each start and finish point and at the Clerk of Course Discretion.

## **30. Awards**

Awards will be awarded at the organisers discretion

## **31. Parking, Camping and Food**

There will be officials/signs to advise on parking /service areas.

Camping is available through the HQ Plantations website. (Permit and Fees are applicable)

Food and drinks will not be available at Rally HQ. Nearest shop for these is the Byfield Store (approx. 15 Km away)

The nearest toilet facilities are at Waterpark Creek Picnic Area (approx. 6 Km away)

Open fires are STRICTLY PROHIBITED. Use of gas BBQ's or cookers is permitted for the sole purpose of preparing food only.

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
