The course is a one of a kind in Australia, starting at the Poison Creek Bridge at the bottom of the Mt Morgan Range (Burnett Highway) and featuring over three kilometres of tarmac with 26 corners and 160 metre change in elevation. The inaugural one day event in 2018 attracted 75 competitors and over 1,600 spectators.

Parking:

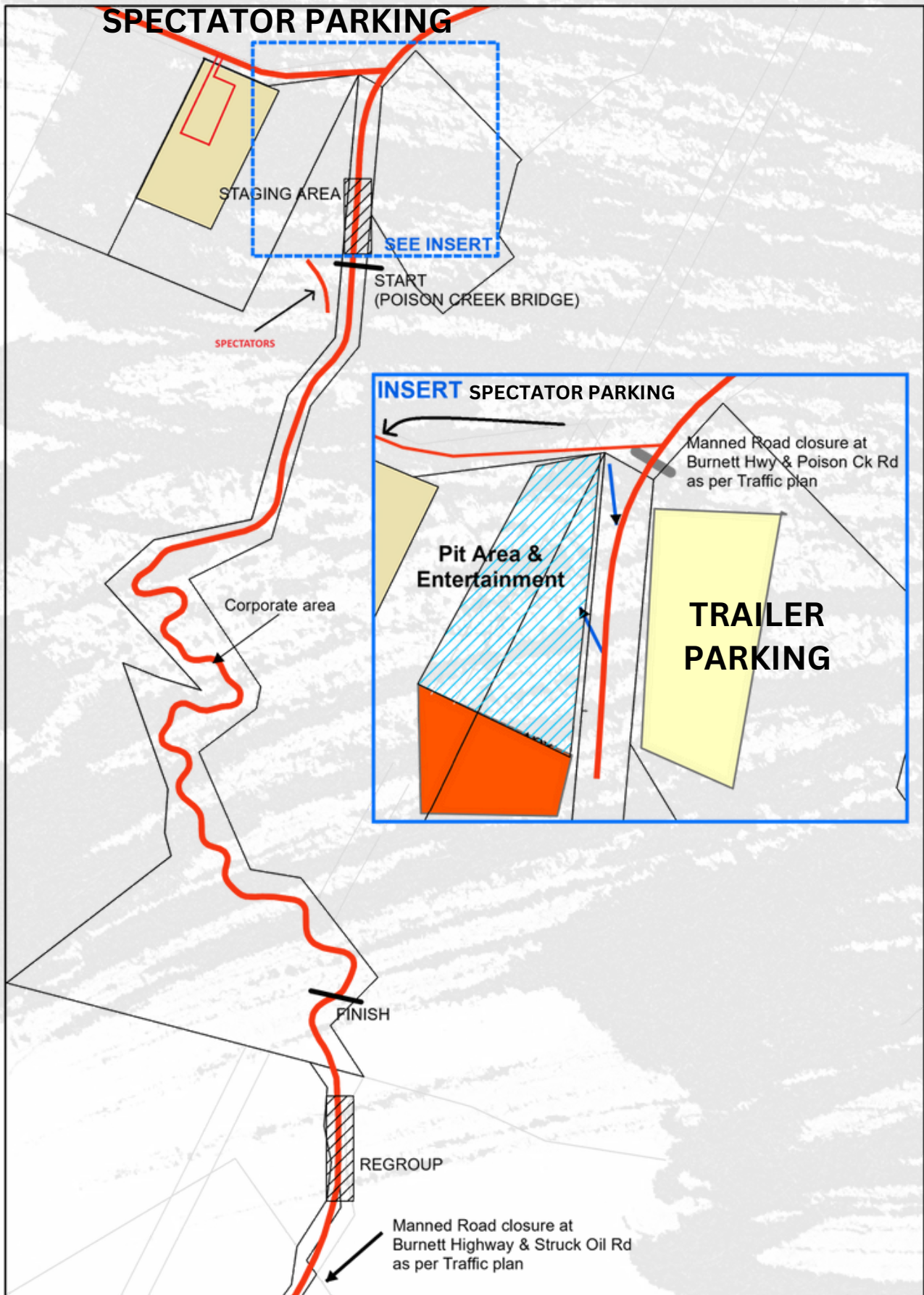

Mount Morgan – The Golden Mountain

Welcome to the historic site of one of the world's most productive gold mines in Central Queensland's charming hinterland.

Commencing operation in 1882, the mine became one of the richest gold mines in Australia, and for a period of time - the world. During its 99 years of mining the area declared a total of 225 tons of gold, 50 tons of silver and 360,000 tons of copper.

The town offers ideal opportunities to delve into the area's early successes and relive its fascinating past with a range of impressive attractions on show, along with museums and tours operating seven days a week.



Bouldercombe – Bouldie Falls



Here in Bouldercombe you will find a friendly, small, rural community, the town first being established after minor gold discoveries in the 1860s.

Bouldercombe once was known as a dairying and orchard area servicing Rockhampton, now has a primary school, public hall and sports complex. Bouldercombe Gorge Resource Reserve is also a great attraction, especially after the recent rain.
