1. The Event

The Event shall be known as **CQMSC Khanacross – Round 1**, a Club event open to members of any Motorsport Australia affiliated club. The Event will be held at **Rosel Park, Rockhampton QLD 4700** and include a **Come and Try Event**. The Event is a Competitive Event, designed to test the skill of the driver and the reliability and mechanical condition of the competing vehicle. The Event will be conducted on closed unsealed surfaces.

2. Authority

The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia, the Khanacross Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or Bulletins that may be issued.

This Event will be held in accordance with Motorsport Australia's Occupational Health and Safety Policy, Integrity Policies, Legal Policies, Risk Management Policies, Safety 1st Framework and any other relevant Policy.

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au.

9. Documentation

Introductory Licenses will be available for purchase on the day of the Event for those who wish to compete as a come and try entrant. (Please still enter online prior to the day). A come and try license can only be used once per yr.

Eligible Entrants **MUST** have one the following and be presented at Documentation on Sunday morning at the Event.

- A current Motorsport Australia Speed/Speed Junior or higher competition licence. (Excluding Introductory licence competitors).
- A current membership of a Motorsports Australia affiliated club (Excluding Introductory licence competitors).
- Third Party Insurance extension (if QLD registered vehicle).

11. Vehicle Requirements

Vehicles must present race ready at scrutineering the morning of the Event.

- Vehicles must comply with Technical Appendix - [Schedule A](#) and [Group 4K](#)
- Each car **MUST** be fitted with a fire extinguisher as per [Technical Appendix – Schedule H](#). It must be secured with bolts (not screws) to bodywork i.e. – floor, transmission tunnel.

- A safety cage is not required. If the vehicle has one, then it must comply with [Technical Appendix – Schedule J](#) Motorsport Australia Manual.
- A safety harness or seat belt MUST be fitted and worn in accordance with ant manufacturers’ instructions. The permitted seat belt and safety harness standards are listed in [Technical Appendix – Schedule I](#). Harnesses must be in date.
- Fuel – each vehicle must only use Commercial fuel ass defined in [Technical Appendix – Schedule G](#).
- Tyres – Street tyres or rally tyres are permitted. No Aggressive mud type tyres.
- Cars must be adequately muffled.
- Front windows must remain up at all times when competing. If the vehicle does not have front windows Motorsport Australia approved window nets or arm restraints must be used.
- Each vehicle must be fitted with a seatbelt cutter glass breaker mounted securely within reach of the driver with the seatbelt on.
- This is not an EV sanctioned event.

12. Apparel

- Each driver and passenger, as a minimum must wear non-flammable clothing, wrist to ankle coverage and non-flammable footwear.
- Each driver and passenger must wear a helmet in accordance with [Schedule D](#) of the Motorsport Australia Manual. No skull caps will be permitted. Any stickers or paint on the helmet that has not been put there by the manufacture will deem the helmet unacceptable.

13. Camping/Catering

- Camping will be allowed in the designated pit area on Saturday night by arrangement ONLY. Toilets will be available but **no showers**.
- Please BYO drinks, snacks and lunch as no catering is available at the event.

14. Penalties

Penalties shall be given as per Item 12 of the [Khanacross Standing Regulations](#).

15. Results

Results shall be determined by the combined total of times across the completed runs, inclusive of penalties. The winner will be the competitor with the lowest combined total time.

16. Integrity

Smoking (including e-cigarettes and vaping) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling or defueling operation.

Motorsport Australia’s National Integrity Framework and relevant Policies, including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy and the Alcohol Policy, apply to any activity sanctioned by Motorsport Australia.

Any participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

17. Passengers

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy. All passengers must comply with the drug and alcohol policy. It is the driver’s responsibility to ensure their passenger complies. Failure to do this may lead to exclusion from the Event. Minimum age for a passenger is 12

An indemnity form MUST be signed prior to undergoing a passenger ride.

18. General

Drivers are responsible for the conduct of their associated crew (pit crew and friends). If unruly behaviour from associated crew happens it may lead to expulsion from the Event.
