As our club does most of the work but is then charged for the use of the area it is not viable to continue this meeting. Therefore the June S1 rally has been cancelled.
- Brooke and Tony have been in discussions with RRC about an alternative venue to run all our events. To date 5 events have had to be cancelled due to rain. There have been positive talks with Councilor Rutherford for CQMSC to have a forever home near Stanwell, by the Kabra overpass. This area has the potential to be developed. There is also an area near Pink Lilly that has been discussed. We are currently waiting for a reply from council. We could consider business advertising to help with costs for a new area and access grants. Things to consider would be dust and hiring a water cart. Toilets would also need to be organised.
- Darryl is currently undertaking a stock take for the club and shelves have been built.
- A working bee is required before Kanacross. The date would be 24<sup>th</sup> May. Ben can be asked to grade.
- DC motors have a BBQ trailer that we can use for events.
- Darryl has fixed the back door, and it has been painted.
- Tony will organise a locksmith, possibly Ruswin.
